European Championship attracts Champion entry

British Junior Champion Ian Campbell and Slovenian National Champion Jernej Vuga are the latest champions to confirm their entry for the EFRA European Championship 1:8 IC Track B 2007. The pair join Irish National Champion Clive Connolly who last month announced he would travel to Tolmin in Slovenia for the May 25-27 event.

16-year-old Campbell, who comes from Ireland but concentrates on the British Championship, will make his second EC-B appearance at the Bonisio backed event having raced at last year's championship in France. Driving a Serpent 960FD, the Elite RC backed racer said, 'I am treating the event as an opportunity to expand my knowledge of the car on foreign tracks and in doing so hopefully a good result will be the outcome'.

Multiple Slovenian National Champion Vuga is being tipped as one of the favourites for this year's EC-B title but the Nova Rossi backed driver is keen to play down this fact. 'I really don't want to put anymore pressure than needed on myself. Being the National Champion now for a number of years is nice indeed, but becoming European Champion is something very different', commented the Nova Gorica racer. A former European B Vice-Champion having finished second in the 2003 Championship at Lostallo in Switzerland, the experienced 27-year-old international racer does have the added advantage of extensive local track knowledge. Interestingly Vuga, a Serpent driver for many years has switched to Mugen for his 2007 campaign.

The EFRA European Championship 1:8 IC Track B 2007 is building up to be one of the most exciting championships yet with over 70 drivers representing 13 nations expected to travel to Slovenia in late May.
