With the new rules for this 2007 Season, to attend the EFRA Grand Prix you only need your National Licence, the need of the EFRA licence has been eliminated, although if you have your EFRA Licence you always take precedence:

“Rule 4.3.1 ...//... Drivers with an International EFRA licence take precedence over non-EFRA licensed drivers at EFRA Grand Prix in the event of over subscription.”

The entry fee at the EFRA Grand prix is 40 € maximum.



To check the attendance and make final figures for EFRA the complete results of the EFRA GP must be sent to the EFRA Section Chairman within 14 days of the end of the race. Is it clear enough?

I am absolutely confident on the attendance of the EFRA Grand Prix of France, as per its character of Warm-up of the European Championship A it will be crowded for sure.

Our first race of the year is the Grand Prix of Belgium at Bouffioulx, in the roundabouts of Charleroi city. Right now, as per today, 50 drivers are enlisted and there is still nearly 2 months for that race so hopefully the organizer will have a figure in between 80-100 drivers present. Go to <http://www.bbttc.be> site and check it, for sure it will be a race to visit if you are nearby.

Although I have tried to achieve it, our calendar, even limited to 4 GPs per year, is clashing against some national calendar dates, not so many but some, however, try to be fair with our Organizers and to avoid coincidence of dates, please.

Joined are the data I have achieved to get together for the 2007 season. Would you mind to complete it?

That is all from my side, now I need your help.

What I need is:

1<sup>st</sup>. Your National Race calendar for our class for the 2007 Season.

2<sup>nd</sup>. Your National Results of the 2006 Season (if possible complete ones).

3<sup>rd</sup>. List of RC Magazines on your countries.

4<sup>th</sup>. List of RC 1/8 Buggy Off Road web-sites at your country where I would be able to find useful information.
