Important Section letter

The 1/8th IC Off Road Section of the European Federation of Radio Operated Model Automobiles, E.F.R.A., has detected an important mistake on the handbook 2009 in regards to the technical way to measure the width of the car.

The problem is a transcription problem of the agreements of past AGM, more than 5 pair of eyes checked and re-checked its wording, and before publishing the EFRA handbook its wording is checked again; even so, probably due to a confusion of the Section Chairman, main and only responsible only myself, there is a mistake. The measuring box **MUST NOT BE INCLINATED IN ANY ANGLE**, the proposal related to this was withdraw or at least this is the minuted content of the acts of the meeting. So that there is a mistake at page 96 of the handbook, rule 5.1.h were the expression "The flat base shall be placed with an inclination of 20°" must be considered as a mistake and not taken into account.

This has been detected thanks to the diligent work of the Main Referee of the VI European Championships B 1/8 I.C. Off Road held in Gland (Switzerland) the second weekend of June, 12-14. Drivers from 16 countries were present with the sole absence of the Cyprus ones and the presence of a new Baltic republic in the class, Lithuania (Lietuva). Welcome.



The event, organized by the Buggy Club de La Cote and the swiss federation, SRCCA, has been perfectly run on a purpose built facility. The race has been a huge success and all memories of this event will be positive ones.
