Remarkable events of the next year Calendar will be our traditional top Eurochamps spread all over Europe, Eurochamp season will start in France with the 1/12 electric track event at Montbrison on March 7-9, second big event will take place at Lostallo track, CH, and will be the Euro-B of 1/8 IC Track on May 31-1, later on our European summer the weekend of 25-27 July will allocate 2 Eurochamps 1/5 Scale and 1/8 IC Track, venues Luxemburg and Oslo respectively.

The other busy weekend will be the 8-10 August with 3 major Eurochamps at Vila Real (Portugal, 1/10 IC Track), Slough (Great Britain, 1/8 IC Off Road) and Vienna (Austria 1/10 El. Off Road)

Last main Eurochamp will take place as well in Austria one week later, on 15-17 August at Kirchberg and will be the 1/10 Electric Touring event.

Besides our main events, Eurochamps, 3 events deserves special focussing, two of them in the 1/8 IC Off Road scene and one in the 1/5 Scale one. The Events in Off road will be 2 international races open to drivers all over the world, Slough warm-up on April 25-27 and Furulund (Sweden) World Warm-up on May 23-25. The other "must-be-there" event will be the Lloret (Spain) 1/5 Scale world race on October 23-25 celebrate as one of the main events of the FIA World Rally Championship "Rally de Catalunya".
