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Safety comes first

Hello my RC friends

Bilbao, 14th February 2011

A new season is ready to start; it is going to be an interesting one, rather demanding for your EFRA responsible as we are to implement new rules to be policed at our events.

As you might recall at 2009 EFRA AGM we approved the limit on the percentage of nitro content at fuel mixture, 25 %. This rule has come into force 1st Jaunary this year so fuel test will be done at our races.

It is my intention to try to keep it easy for everyone using Nitromax 25 % as first primary test system, there is no reason at our class to search for a limit so don't put yourself in risk and go for a secure fuel. It has been said to me that at other continents the cans of 25 % are really on the limit while the European cans of fuel are normally with some margin and so that safer o be used. Anyhow that is yet to be checked out.

Mentioning Nitromax 25 does not mean we aren't able to go for accurate test, most probably a specific device will be used at the Euros able to look after the non allowed additives at fuel mixture.

This is not the only new rule we have to apply, I must recall you on the opening sentence of this letter, Safety comes first, this is linked to the charging of your LiPo/LiFe batteries. For such a "LiPo Sack" is mandatory at all EFRA classes, cost of it is nearly peanuts so please, buy one and USE IT.

Following the principle settled with that sentence we must highlight that the bumpers must be made from flexible material, this is the end of the war tanks we have seen this past year, yes car must be able to hold the track, but not based on a II WW adaptation.

Regarding race rules the main changes are the creation of Euro Indoor event and the possibility at all European championships for the TQ driver to practice at BOTH semifinals practice, A & B, giving some value to the effort of such achievement.

Soon you will able to find the updated EFRA handbook 2011 at the EFRA webpage, http://www.efra.ws Let us now enter on an analysis of the Season.

Start of it will be the always interesting NEO Race at Harper Adams UK, the 22-25 April, the website for the race is http://theneorace.com/ and I can hardly encourage you to attend it as most probably the event is fully book since months ago.

Our second event of the season will be widely attended in order to prepare the Euro A, it will be the EFRA GP of Germany at Sand Am Main the 13-15 May, the web site of the event is http://www.euroa2011.mscdsand.de/

Obviously this page will be valid as well for our biggest event of the year, the XXXI (31) European Championship A 1/8th I.C. Off Road to be held at same venue the first week of August, with the main final on Saturday 6th as usual. This will be my 20th ECA at our class, so lets try to have a great time there.
