The licence must be produced personally at registration. The organizer will register the licence numbers of all drivers and record these in the final results.

Drivers with an international EFRA licence take precedence over non-EFRA licenced drivers at EFRA Grand Prix in the event of over subscription.

Time keeping

MRC Real80 uses the AMBrc race timing system / MyRCM lap counting software.

Transponders

All drivers must have their own AMB (or compatible) Personal Transponder.

Frequencies

- Allowed frequencies are 27 MHz, 30 MHz, 40 MHz range and 2,4 GHz Spectrum.
- Best is to use only 2.4 GHZ. This because of interference on the track!!!!!!!!!!!!!

Entry fee

- The entry fee is € 40,- per driver.
- Drivers have to show their EFRA licence or country licence.
- Drivers need to have a national license.

Classes / Participants

- Formula 1: maximum 34 drivers
- Touring Car: maximum 76 drivers

Track open / closed

- The track will be closed on Thursday 30th June for track preparations. The track will be available for track members till Wednesday 29th of June. Thursday 30th is the driving fee € 7,50 euro a day for GP drivers. The track is closed for track members on this Thursday. The fee for the Friday, Saturday and Sunday (3 days) will be €40,= euro.
- The track will be opened on Friday 1th of July for controlled/free practice.

Counter clockwise.



General Race Instructions / pre-briefing

General

- Time scheduling follows on the Thursday 30 June.
- No entry without your badge!
- No active cellular phone in pit lane or on drivers rostrum!
- No engine running in the paddocks!
- No smoking in the pit lane!

Certified petrol station

The only allowed fuel during he Grand Prix event is available at the SHELL gas station, located at the Europaweg 6, 9723 AS Groningen (050 3123640), which is less than 4 km / 3 min. away from the MRC Real80 track.



Start of heats (Flying start)

- 3min > 2min > 1minute to the start. 30 seconds -> announcement of start of heat by horn
- Starting order of heats is always: Car # 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10.

Starting of finals

- 30 seconds before the start : Cars to the starting grid.
- All finals: 1 Trial lap before every final.
- Back to the box (No part of car touching the white line), countdown from 10.
- Starting signal = horn.
- Early start = Stop & Go 10 seconds penalty. (Last 10 seconds movement of car)
- Delay in the start (semi-finals & final) means starting at the end of the grid.

Mechanics

- During the heats only 1 mechanic allowed. During finals 2 mechanics allowed. Mechanic(s) always right under the driver.
- Always put on the given clothing.

Stop & Go

- Small location, outlined white, at the end of pit lane. (Access through pit lane)
- No adjusting whatsoever allowed during Stop & Go!

Car impound

- Impound at the Technical Inspection directly after finish of heat or final.
- No car impound means automatically disqualification.

Registration

Registration for the event ends on the 29th of June on 22:00 hours (CET).
