N.B. No new types of rechargeable battery will be homologated after 31st December each year, e.g. a new type of rechargeable battery goes on sale in August 2003. Subject to the battery meeting the requirements, then it will appear on the homologation list published on 1st January 2004 and will be eligible for use in EFRA sanctioned events from 1st April 2004.

All of the cells on the above list will be allowed at the 1/12th European Championships to be held at Montbrison in France from 7th to 9th March 2003.
