Track info: The track and the Arena was built in the summer 2014 when MK Eskil

moved from Arena Bredängen to Eskilstuna Motorsportcenter, Gröndal. It is probably one of the largest and fastest race tracks in the world with a

possibility to build a number of different layouts.

The longest track layout is 538 meters. The straights and dosed bends are 6,4 meters wide and the reaming part of the track is 4.4 meters wide. The

surface is a smooth and well drained tarmac.

Pit area: 100 places under roof. 230v outlets is available for each one. Adapter that

fits the outlet is the driver's responsibility to bring.

The electric current in Sweden is 230 volts and 50 hertz. Plugs and sockets are the same as in the continental countries of the European Union.


