Track: The longest track layout is 538 meters. The straights and dosed bends are 6.4 meters wide and the remaining part of the track is 4.4 meters wide. The surface is a smooth and well drained tarmac.

Drivers Pit: 100 places under roof. 230v outlets is available for each one. Adapter that fits the outlet is the driver's responsibility to bring.

The electric current in Sweden is 230 volts and 50 hertz. Plugs and sockets are the same as in the continental countries of the European Union.

Tires: A limited numbers of the EC A 1:8 IC TR control tires, make: Contact (Contact RC Tyres) will be available for purchase at the track. Due to a miscalculation by the tire supplier, Contact RC Tyre, EFRA has accepted and will before long announce a price increase of 2.10€ per set. One set will thus cost 12.60€ instead of €10.50. However this price is still a very competitive price. We apologies for the eventual inconvenience this might cause you.

The Contact tires are not mandatory (Free tires) at the WARM Up / Nordics.
















**License:** Licenses according to respective federation rules **Entry:** 375 SEK for one class. 550 SEK for two classes
