**Track:** The track and the arena was built in the summer 2014 when MK Eskil moved to Eskilstuna Motorsportcenter Gröndal. It is one of the largest and fastest race tracks in Europe and probably also in the world.

The track layout is 429 meters. The main straight is 5,5-6,0 meters wide and 70 meters long, the reaming part of the track is min. 4.5 meters wide. The surface is clay, carpet and concrete slabs and the track are well drained.

The track will be closed from Friday 5th Aug to 12th Aug.

**Drivers Pit:** 96 places under roof. 230v outlets is available for each one. Adapter that fits the outlet is the driver's responsibility to bring.
