Dear RC -friends!

This newsletter should be considered as a complement to our homepage www.mkeskil.se which we recommend you to visit. The newsletter will be issued rather frequently and contain information regarding activities mainly related to our major races.

Nordic Championship 2016 1/8 and 1/10 IC Track & Warm up for EC 1/8 Track.

This race will be the first outdoor race of the year at our track, Gröndal Ring Eskilstuna Sweden and will take place at May 27-29, 2016 and we hope to see you all there, Nordics as well as European drivers. It is rather easy to find the track since it is close to the E20.

What has been done and will be done in order to organize a pleasant race?

- The track will be prepared so the grip will be perfect. Equipment has been developed.
- Fuel can be bought at the track. It will make it easier to travel.
- Covered pit for all drivers/mechanics. Of course electrical power is available enough for all.
- For those of you that will come with mobile homes, parking will hopefully be very close to the track. Discussions with the community is going on.
- Warm food will be served as well as fast-food during the race days to reasonable prices. Refreshments is of course available.
- On Saturday night a banquet will be held downtown Eskilstuna. All on the clubs expense.

We have made agreements regarding prices with a number of hotels in Eskilstuna, (please see our homepage). We have appointed one hotel as our first choice: **Clarion Collection Hotel, Bolinder Munktell** (State **MKEskil2016** when booking). The code is valid for all races. Please note that all prices includes VAT.

For a price of €90 you get a very nice double room downtown and included in the price is breakfast, afternoon coffee (maybe mainly for family members when you will be at the track) and an evening buffet. EVERY DAY/EVENING. We consider the price as unbeatable.

However since May is a month with a lot of activities, events and conferences in Eskilstuna, do we recommend you to book your accommodation as soon as possible. We have only managed to block 25 rooms. *For more information see our homepage.*

In addition to what has been mentioned above for the Nordic championship and Warm Up regarding preparation, fuel, hotels etc. following should be added;

- Control tires will follow the EFRA regulations. However an idea has come up how to reduce tire cost The idea will be brought forward the EFRA chairman 1/8 and see if it is possible by that reduce cost.
- If needed transportation could be organized from the airports to the hotel and/or track back and forth for a reasonable cost. For those who also need transportation back and forth from the hotel - the track can that also be arranged. This service has however to be booked in beforehand.
- The banquet on Friday night will be held in a rebuilt factory that now serves as a museum for construction machines (you can see old processing machines and old as well as new construction machines) Entertainment will also happen during the dinner. All on our expense.
- The event will of course be covered by the EFRA Media Partner.

Due to that the track, Gröndal Ring, is situated at a large Motorsport Center some other motorsport activities will probably be arranged during the race week. (Such as drifting, Go kart, Motocross, four wheel driving, Speedway. Possibilities to test will be given.)

Negotiations with other clubs is going on. On Tuesday night, the race week, a speedway match in the Swedish Elite Liege will be run. Negotiations regarding free tickets is going on.
