Summary of Requirements:

Minimum requirements:

- Do interviews in the pits with drivers/mechanics, and race relevant people, and after the race with the winner, the second and third place.

The Media Partner(s) must provide pictures, written and video reports on the EFRA Facebook pages and EFRA webpage, and distribute reports to other RC related news pages, RC websites, magazines etc.
Do a live stream of the main finals (or at least a video of the main finals that will be put on the media shortly after the end of the race)

- Pictures should create a reflection of the atmosphere, an extra attention to the younger drivers should be given in the coverage.

- Coverage of the price ceremony on the track
- Create daily event reports for the EFRA webpage and make them available to other media for publication.
- Management of the Facebook page/Youtube cannel and other media
- Promote our Associated members

Nice to have:

- Commentary of the finals, it can be the announcer at the racetrack
- Pre announcement-promotion of the races on Facebook and other media
- Coverage of the opening ceremony

EFRA is seeking for an agreement of two years, starting on March 2019 with an option for EFRA to extend the contract for a further period.

The live broadcast should be exposed in such way that it also reaches the general public outside the RC Car Community without any charge for viewing.

Obviously, as the official language of EFRA is English, the collaboration and all publications must be done in the English language. EFRA will further insist that competitors from all countries have similar exposure and manufacturers and their equipment used at the event are treated fairly.

The EFRA Logo has to be visible all the time.

All costs related to this agreement is assumed to be handled by the appointed Media Partner and will not be covered by EFRA. The duties of the Media Partner(s) will be under the authority of the relevant EFRA Official.

EFRA wishes to contract the services of a Media Partner(s) to cover and broadcast all the EFRA European Championships. The dates mentioned below are meant as an example, and might vary each year.
