LOCATION

Gengenbach is a picturesque medieval town in Germany's Black Forest, known for its half-timbered houses, cobblestone streets, and historic market square. Often called the "jewel of the Black Forest," it boasts a well-preserved old town, charming towers and gates, and a lively cultural scene.

In winter, Gengenbach becomes especially famous for hosting the world's largest Advent calendar, when the town hall's 24 windows transform into festive displays.

Surrounded by vineyards and forested hills, it's an inviting destination for wine lovers, hikers, and those seeking authentic Black Forest charm.







ARRIVAL

Situated in the tri-border region of Germany, France, and Switzerland, Gengenbach is easy to reach by several means of transport:

By car – via the Autobahn A5 and Bundesstraße B33

By **train** – Gengenbach can be reached directly by train. From Offenburg (10 minutes), there are also various national and international long-distance train connections. A shuttle service will be available on request.

By **plane** – from nearby airports:

Strasbourg - 40 km

Karlsruhe/Baden-Baden - 57 km

EuroAirport Basel-Mulhouse-Freiburg – 140 km

Stuttgart - 150 km

Frankfurt - 214 km (good train connection)

Zurich - 218 km

CAMPING

Trackside camping is available with space for up to 30 camper vans and motor-homes. Facilities include showers and toilets in the nearby clubhouse, as well as 230V power connections (personal power reels required).

Camping is free of charge, though a voluntary donation to the farmer for providing the meadow is greatly appreciated.

- scenic mountain landscapes, hiking trails, and a crystal-clear lake

Vogtsbauernhof Open-Air Museum

- authentic farmhouses and traditions of Black Forest life

Black Forest Nature Park

- endless trails, dense forests, and panoramic viewpoints

Baden-Baden

- famed for its thermal spas, Belle Époque flair, and casino culture

Strasbourg & Colmar

- Alsatian gems just across the border, rich in history and charm











THE CLUB

The **E**lectric **D**rive **C**lub (**EDC**) **Kinzigtal** is an RC car club with its own permanent 1:10 scale outdoor off-road racetrack in Gengenbach's Reichenbach district, nestled in the scenic Black Forest.

Founded over 30 years ago, we are part of **Sportverein Reichenbach 1956 e.V.** and today count around 80 enthusiastic members of all ages, with numbers continuing to grow.

Every year, we host several national and international racing events, attracting up to 275 registered participants—a testament to our club's reputation and passion for the sport. We are also proud members of the **Deutscher Minicar Club e.V.** (DMC), the German governing body for RC racing.


THE TRACK

The 160 m long, 3 m wide off-road track offers a variety of challenging features, including multiple jumps, a 180-degree banked corner, a bridge, and a 30 m straight.

Concrete beveled curbs and a grass infield provide clearly defined track limits while remaining gentle on delicate race cars. A covered drivers' rostrum, 11 m wide, accommodates up to 12 drivers and includes separate entry and exit points for smooth operation.

The track layout will be updated ahead of the European Championship to ensure a fresh and exciting racing experience.

Ample spectator seating will also be available around the track.









TRACK SURFACE

In spring 2025, our track has been upgraded with a completely new clay surface.

Working in cooperation with a company specializing in clay path construction, we introduced the additive TERRASOLID®, which is even approved for use in nature reserves.

By ionizing the soil, the system maintains a constant moisture level of 16.8%, ensuring exceptional durability while preserving the natural characteristics of the surface. The result is a super-robust track offering medium to high grip.

Already this year, three major events – including one with 275 participants – have been held without the need for any surface repairs.

RACING INFRASTRUCTURE

The pit area will be set up in a large tent directly next to the track, providing sufficient paddock space and boxes for all drivers. Each participant will have a minimum of 1 × 1 m workspace.

Facilities include 230V power outlets and a dedicated cleaning station with compressed air and running water. Teams wishing to set up their own pavilions will also find ample space available.

The timing system is operated using an AMB Decoder (latest firmware) together with MyRCM Ultimate software. Results are displayed on electronic scoreboards at both the rostrum and the pit area, while a PA system keeps drivers and spectators up to date.

Wi-Fi access is available on request, though reliable 4G and 5G coverage is already in place.

A designated area for the referee and media crew will be provided next to the rostrum, ensuring excellent visibility of both the drivers' stand and the track.

CATERING

On-site catering will be available for the duration of the event, serving a selection of freshly prepared hot meals at lunchtime. Throughout the day, a variety of snacks and beverages will also be on offer.

For those who prefer additional choices, several supermarkets, the local pizzaria and other restaurants are located nearby, providing a wide range of alternatives.







SANITARY FACILITIES

For the event, toilets will be available directly at the venue. In addition, the club house, located right next to the track, provides further amenities including modern restrooms, changing rooms, and shower facilities for both men and women.


ELECTRICITY

EDC Kinzigtal


