## 02 THE CIRCUITS

### ASPHALT SURFACE

Route designed by Iñaki Montessinos, a renowned specialist in Spain. It has a length of 380 meters and an average width of 5 meters.

It is a very demanding track due to its elevation changes, chicanes and high speed curves. It usually turns counterclockwise with 9 left turns and 6 right turns, triple chicanes and a main straight of 70 meters.

### GROUND SURFACE



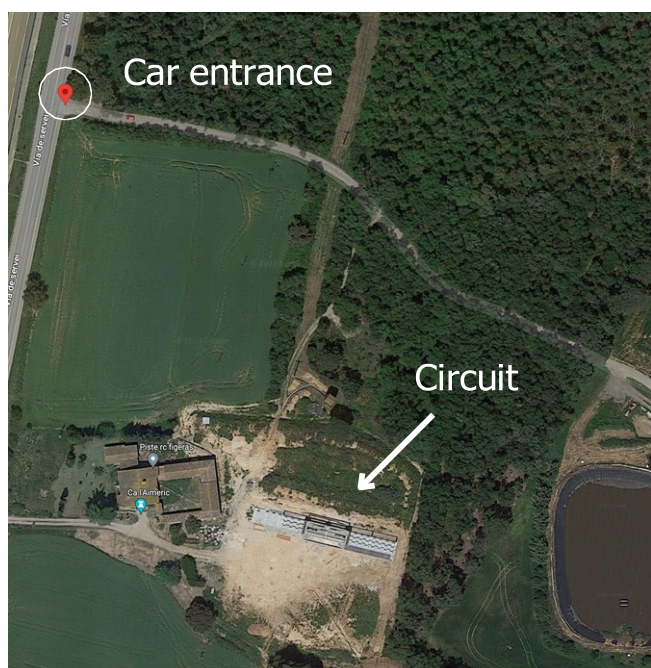
*Very peculiar and unique in Spain*

## 06 CLIMATE

Girona has a Mediterranean climate with continental influences. The climate of Girona is transitional Mediterranean, with relatively mild and rainy winters and hot and sunny summers.

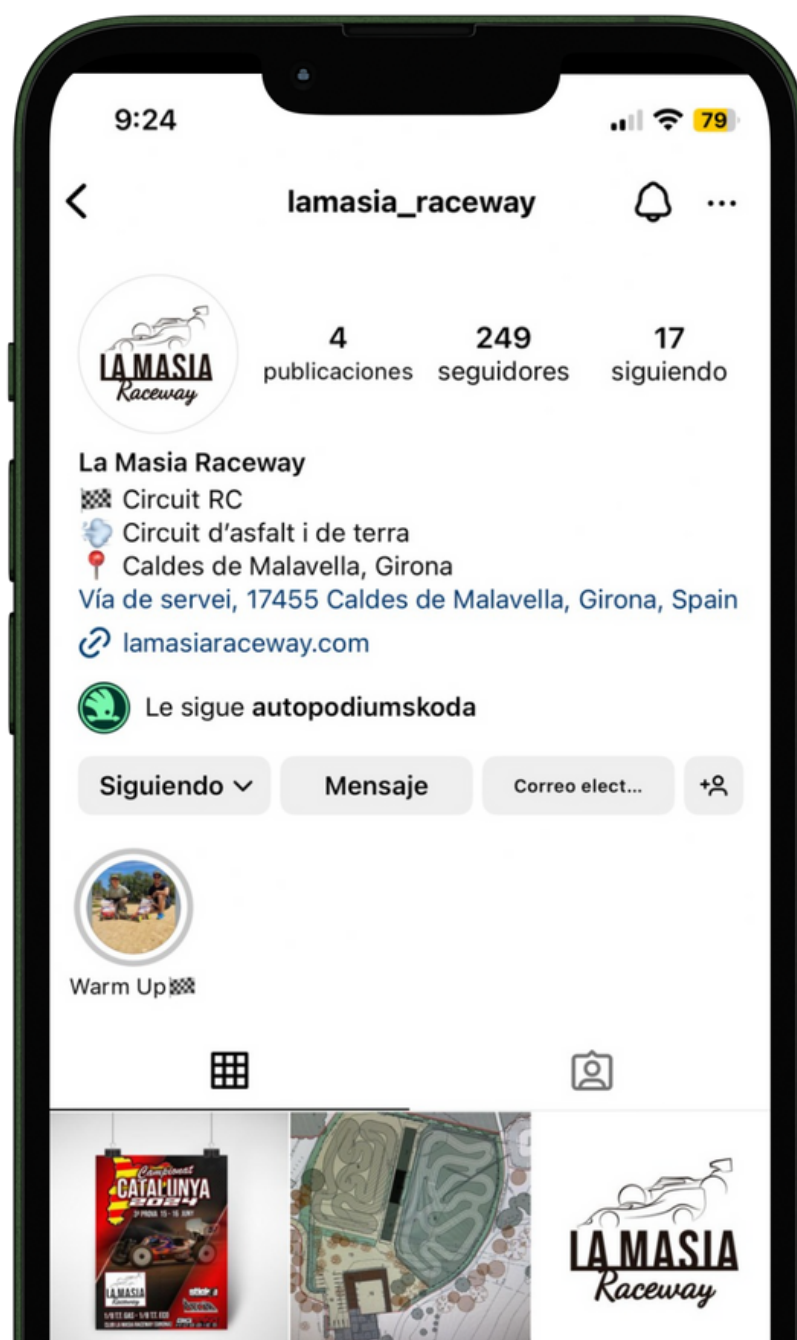
The city is located in the northeast of Spain and Catalonia, about 25 km from the sea. The coast of the province of Girona is called Costa Brava.

The distance from the sea, although not very large, makes the climate a little more continental than on the coast, in addition, due to the northern position, near the border with France, the city is more exposed to the cold waves of November-March compared to Barcelona, and the rains are also more frequent.

The average temperature of the coldest month (January) is 7.5 °C, that of the warmest months (July, August) is 24 °C. Precipitation amounts to 720 mm per year: it is therefore at an intermediate level.



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
