It has been more than a decade since Spain last hosted an EFRA Off-Road European Championship, which took place in 2013 in Alcaraz (Catalonia).

THE CLUB

An extensive curriculum support us. Since our recent founding, the “Los Eucaliptos” circuit, located in the area of the San Gregorio sports facilities, has hosted two national rounds of the 1/6 Scale Off-Road National Championship in 2022 and 2023. Last year, a Night Race was also held (September 2), along with the Northern Zone Championship and a Truggy Open (November 11). This year, several more sporting events are already confirmed, including the National 1/5 Scale Gas Off-Road Championship.

The Track location

The facilities of our circuit are located on the outskirts of our town, Sonseca, a municipality very close to the capital of Spain, Madrid. The circuit is situated within the sports area, very near the tennis and paddle courts, a football pitch, and also the two municipal swimming pools (one indoor and one outdoor). This proximity offers some advantages, such as municipal services with hot showers, baths accessible for people with disabilities, and a restaurant area at the nearby outdoor municipal swimming pool.

Thanks to municipal support, we have been able to add public services within the circuit facilities, as well as a bar/cafeteria service during the races themselves.

The railway station in the city of Toledo, away only 24 kms from Sonseca, is listed as one of the country's historic stations, declared of cultural interest. It is located on Paseo de la Rosa S/N, just a 20-minute walk from the city center.

It offers medium-distance and high-speed services, connecting Toledo with Madrid in a 30-minute journey. The opening hours are from Monday to Friday except holidays: 06:00 a.m. to 10:30 p.m. - Saturdays, Sundays and holidays from 8:00 a.m. to 10:30 p.m.

Mail and Package Delivery Service

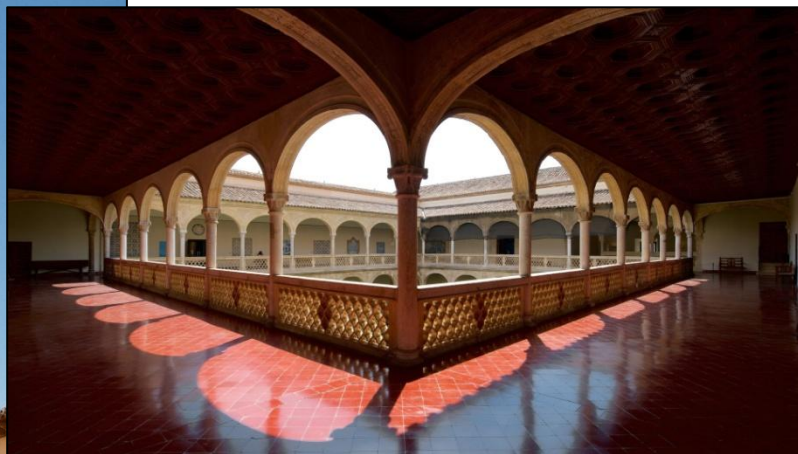
All drivers and families may deliver their mail, package and parcels by sending them to the local SportsHall "Felix Rodriguez Malo", located in C/ San Gregorio, 28. Sonseca (Toledo).

Feel comfortable to deliver all your package and parcels by putting in contact with the sports coordinator in town, Armando Miguel. It is near to the sports area, so you hardly have to move from the spot.

Toledo Province Attractions

Since the Roman days, Toledo has been a center of life on the hills of central Spain. A city of churches, swordsmiths, and medieval roads, the old Spanish capital offers a lively atmosphere along with the old Moorish citadels, Spanish Renaissance masterworks, and broad plains of Castilla-La Mancha. Winding cobblestone roads wrap around buildings that date back to the Holy Roman Empire, hilltop castles offer a grand piece of historic scenery, and a great selection of sights and things to do in Toledo help to make it one of the most popular destinations in Spain.

Historic District

Bounded by the banks of the Tagus to the south and the old fortifications to the north, Toledo's core is a walled city that possesses four civilizations' worth of landmarks clustered on a maze of narrow streets. Medieval walls still stand on the hillside, and the cityscape is dotted with little plazas surrounded by pubs and cafés.

What to See in Toledo

Climb to the Alcázar at the top of Toledo's main hill to get a 150-degree view of the banks of the Tagus. At the medieval Castle of San Servando, get an up-close look at city walls that date back to the Romans, with stages built across the centuries by the Visigoths, Moors, and Spanish. The area is filled with reminders of the city's trio of religious influences, from the Synagogue of El Transito to the former mosque of Cristo de la Luz and the Monastery of San Juan de los Reyes that was built for Ferdinand and Isabella.

Sightseeing in Toledo Province

The people of Toledo have preserved the centuries of traditions that have built up in the city, with ample examples, masterworks of Damascene art, and finely forged swords showing off the artisans' and makers' skills. The Museum of Santa Cruz is a great place to check out handicrafts and décor in a former medieval hospital, while the El Greco Museum in the Jewish Quarter shows off the painter's great mannerist works in a reconstruction of his home.

Set aside some time for a walk through the historic city, and consider teaming up with a guide to point out the sites you shouldn't miss. Get a look at Toledo's Roman foundations with a trip through the ruins of the city's underground, or pick up a bicycle to ride out to the city's beautiful newer districts or along the shores of the Tagus.

For adventures beyond Toledo's city limits, you can explore charming little villages like Lagartera, famous for its embroidered cloth, and the medieval houses of Oropesa. Satisfy your literary curiosities by following the Route of Don Quixote to see the landmarks named in Cervantes' classic novel, go for an active hike into the Toledo Mountains.

The circuit is part of the Sonseca Municipal Sports Complex, surrounded by tennis and padel courts, football pitches, and Both summer and winter pools

Los Eucaliptos circuit offers a thrilling yet balanced layout, designed for both speed and technical precision.

Total length: 325 meters

Surface: compact dirt with grassed areas, bordered by corrugated piping for safety and visual appeal

MAIN HIGHLIGHTS

PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM

The start of each race is indicated with flags and acoustic start signals.

Through the same sound system, penalties and driver warnings are also announced clearly to all participants and spectators.



POWERFUL /LIGHTING SYSTEM

Equipped with high-performance LED floodlights, allowing the organization of night races under optimal visibility conditions.

Additionally, The circuit has power outlets for the islands located under the Paddock.



TIMING SYSTEM

Dual integrated timing system.

Race tracking through a chip system integrated into the vehicles.

Referee stand and public address system for supervising the race.
